

How to Catch a Turkey

STEM Activity

Thank you for downloading this FREE resource at ChildCareEd! This STEM activity can be done as either a small or whole-group activity after the book *How to Catch a Turkey* by Adam Wallace is read to children.

The STEM activity is made up of two little activities:

Make a turkey

Materials needed:

1. cardboard rolls cut up into thirds
2. Orange paper triangles
3. Googly eyes
4. Feathers
5. Glue/Tape

Hide the turkey

1. Turkeys created by children
2. Materials such as paper, blocks, books


Directions:

1. After children create their turkeys, they will work either individually or in groups to “hide” their turkeys. The children can take turns visiting each group and see if they “spot” the turkeys.
